



# East Asian Languages and Cultures Major, Japanese Specialization

## Program Requirements

- **Total units required:** 27-47 (24 upper-level units, plus 3-23 prerequisite units); 33-53 for students pursuing Senior Honors

### Prerequisites

- First and second levels of Japanese (or the equivalent) (0-20 units)
- Students are required to complete one of the following Civilization courses (3 units):

### Requirements

Students must complete eight courses for a minimum of 24 upper-level units (300 level or above), including the following. Five of the eight courses must focus on Japanese (15 units).

1. **Students are required to complete one EALC Seminar course (topic varies by semester). The EALC Seminar may also fulfill one of the premodern or modern requirements (3 units).**
