Elective Courses

Prerequisites

The prerequisite courses for Econ 4011 are Econ 1011 and Math 132. In addition, Econ 493 or Math 233 must be taken prior to or concurrently with enrollment in Econ 4011.

- All courses in the minor (including Mathematics) must be completed with the letter grade option, and a grade of at least C- must be earned in each course.
- Minors in an approved study abroad program may receive transfer credit for one economics elective at the 300 level. Preapproval from the department's study abroad advisor is required.
